CERTIFICATION

The High Country Newfoundland Club has been granted permission to hold this Draft Test by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America in accordance with the Draft Test Regulations; Copyright 1999, Newfoundland Club of America; Revised May 2022, Effective July 1, 2022.

TEST SITE DESCRIPTION

Fairmount Park is part of the Prospect Park Recreation District. It is a lovely, quiet park nestled in a beautiful residential neighborhood. With a 60-car capacity paved parking lot and a handicapped-accessible restroom facility, this is the district's largest park. There are three clustered picnic pavilions with charcoal grills. The large shelter has four eight-foot tables and one grill. The other two smaller pavilions each have two eight-foot tables and one grill. A large playground area is adjacent to the pavilions. This park includes a regulation soccer field, a basketball hoop, a horseshoe pit, and a recently enlarged riding arena for equestrians. A half-mile walking/jogging perimeter trail encompasses the park. There are approximately four acres of turf grass. There is also a large natural grass area available for use as a freight haul or maneuvering course. Porta Potties are available.

DIRECTIONS

From the north or east or south, take I-70 west to CO HWY 58 West. Take HWY 58 West to the McIntyre St. exit. Turn right onto McIntyre St. Turn left onto W. 54th Ave. Turn left onto Quaker St. The park will be at the end of the street on the left.

From the South: Take C470 to 6th Ave. West. Follow 6th Ave. West to HWY 58. Exit onto McIntyre St. Turn left onto McIntyre St. Turn left onto Quaker St. The park will be at the end of the street on the left.

REGULATIONS

The Draft Test is sanctioned by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) and is sponsored by the High Country Newfoundland Club (HCNC). Judging will be conducted under the approved NCA Draft Test Regulations, revised May 2022 and effective July 1, 2022 as available on the NCA website. Entrants participate in an NCA Draft Test at their own risk. Entrants agree to abide by the NCA Draft Test Regulations and the Constitution and By-Laws of the NCA. Entrants are responsible for obtaining and reading the regulations governing NCA Draft Tests. Copies of the regulations may be found online at www.ncanewfs.org

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for the test, team or re-qualification is \$45 per day. Mail entry fees (payable to HCNC), a completed entry form and a copy of your dog's AKC, ILP/PAL or foreign registration to: Lisa Johnson, Test Secretary, 12190 W. 75th Ln, Arvada, CO 80005. OR consider entering and paying online (preferred method) at https://www.ncanewfs.org/wdc/. Entries from within the United States will be accepted by US Mail. There is no USPS, UPS, FedEx next day delivery to the test secretary's address so please plan accordingly. Additionally, do not mail any entries "Signature Required." Foreign entries must show a verifiable mailing date. Entries postmarked prior to February 7, 2024 for NCA Members and February 16, 2024 for all others will be returned. All entries will be confirmed by email only unless the entrants do not have email. Please make sure you provide a legible email address. You will be notified by email of your entry receipt prior to the closing date. After the closing date, entry confirmations will also be sent by email. Closing date of entries is March 9, 2024. Entry fees will be refunded under the following circumstances only: entry is cancelled by notifying the Test Secretary by email, telephone or USPS prior to the closing date; club cancels the test due to minimum entry requirement; entrant is assigned to the alternate list and cancels entry by notifying the Test Secretary by email, telephone or USPS prior to the closing date; alternate entrant does not receive a testing slot by designated check-in time on the day of the test in which they had entered.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Entries for all three testing levels: Beginner, Draft and Excellent are limited to a total of 15 per day combined. The test is open to all breeds with a limit of 5 entries and Newfoundland entries taking precedence. The club reserves the right to cancel the Saturday and Sunday test if a minimum of 5 Newfoundland entries are not received. Entry slots will be filled according to postmark date. Priority will be given to untitled dogs followed by re-qualifiers. All entries will be accepted beginning with postmarks on February 7, 2024 for NCA Members and all others will be accepted beginning with postmarks on February 16, 2024. Entries close at 7:00pm on March 9, 2024 or when the entry is filled, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. In the event that entries exceed the maximum entry limit, a random draw lottery will be held. If entries are filled, an alternate list will be established. Openings will be filled from the alternate list in postmark order. In the event of a postmark tie, a random drawing will be made. No fax, email or phone entries will be accepted. Alternate list dogs not yet having passed the division entered will have priority over requalifier dogs, regardless of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur.

All Breed entries for all three testing levels: Beginner, Draft and Excellent are limited to 5 per day. **This is not an NCA event

Tad-Pull is limited to 5 entries per day. **This is not an NCA event

REQUALIFIERS

Re-qualifiers will be accepted on a space available basis. Untitled dogs will be given first priority even if their entry is postmarked after that of a titled dog.

DDX-TDDX EXHIBITORS – WEIGHT EXCHANGE

The Excellent test weight exchange will be bags of play sand. Each bag measures 16 x 19 inches and each bag weighs 30 lbs. For Team DDX (TDDX) it will be 2 bags of play sand.



NCA POLICY ON DOG AGGRESSION

Any dog that, in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by the Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the Event Committee disqualifies the dog, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated.

OUT OF CONTROL DOG POLICY

OUT OF CONTROL DOG POLICY Approved NCA Board of Directors November 11, 2023 At all NCA Events dogs must be kept under control to prevent harm to itself or others. It is the owner/handler's responsibility to ensure their dogs are under control for the duration of the event. At NCA events dogs must be crated or leashed and collared at all times, except when the dogs are required to perform off leash. When dogs are leashed, the length of the leash must not exceed SIX (6) feet and the leash may NOT be a retractable leash. Dogs should not be allowed to approach another dog without permission from the other dog's owner/handler. Any dog that, in the opinion of the judges, event committee or designated safety officer representing the event, appears dangerous, shall be asked to leave the event promptly or be crated for the duration of the event and is excused from further participation in the event. Anyone who witnesses a dog appearing to be dangerous should bring their concerns to the judges, event committee or safety officer. Part of upholding good sportsmanship is to take action through the appropriate channels. Examples of out of control behavior would include but is not limited to: Aggressive vocalization such as barking and growling, or aggressive behavior toward any person or animal such as snapping, biting, lunging, charging, attacking or attempting to attack at any time while on the test grounds. Owners and handlers are responsible for monitoring the well-being and safety of their dog(s). If left unattended the owner/handler must check on them frequently to ensure they are safe. If the dog is excused from the test grounds for aggression, the automatic grievance policy of the NCA is enacted. If an injury to dog or person occurs, the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows Ch 11, section 15 goes into effect. (References, chapter 2, section 14 in both water and draft regulations)

MISCELLANEOUS/BITCHES IN SEASON

Newfoundland bitches in season will be allowed to participate. However, bitches in season will be judged after ALL other entries have completed the test. When not being tested, bitches in season must be contained away from the official test areas. Please notify the Test Secretary by March 20, 2024 if your bitch is in season or going into season. Bitches that have had an ovarian sparing spay are required to be tested as "Bitches in Season." All breed bitches in season will not be allowed. Unentered dogs must be kept quiet, on leash, or crated and away from the designated test area.
